Forklift Safety Training Regina - Any individual who would like to operate a lift truck has to take a forklift safety training course in order to become a certified forklift truck operator. There are different ways to obtain forklift training. Courses are offered through company forklift certification programs, workforce training agencies, and approved on line and video courses. The price could be minimal (or free of charge) when offered by occupational safety officers on job sites or through employment agencies.

Lift truck operators must be 18 years of age or over, in most countries. Local industry bodies approve forklift safety training programs and require operators to obtain a certificate before operating this type of heavy equipment. A certificate is valid for four years in most areas. Businesses that hire workers to drive forklift trucks could face serious liability issues if operators fail to keep this certificate up to date.

Untrained forklift operators can result in property damage and serious injury because of improper use of the machinery. Training consists of the right loading and driving techniques. Employees should pass a written test in order to be certified. A business will usually designate a supervisor in order to provide hands-on training to new workers. A licensed supervisor should have extensive training in lift truck safety and be certified as a trainer.

Those seeking gainful employment as an operator of a forklift would have numerous options at their disposal to obtain the necessary training and certification. Training may be available to the person through a development agency or an employment agency. Those looking for employment as forklift operators could enroll in forklift safety training programs provided by an approved trainer at an independent location. Manual laborers may find much more job opportunities if they have forklift certification.

The internet provides another option for individuals looking for forklift safety training. Training is offered via video and online formats. Then again, certification generally requires that students write an exam and take a lift truck driving test.
